Peter L. Becker, 85, Bradenton, died February 7, 2005.

He retired after 37 years as treasurer and cashier for American Water Works in Frackville, Pa. He was a Staff Sergeant in the U.S. Army serving in World War II, and received a Purple Heart. He was a member of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Catholic Church, American Legion, V.F.W., Men of Malvern, Elks, Knights of Columbus, Sacred Heart Society; and was a lifelong community organizer and coach.
