OBITUARY

Francis J. Bugdanewicz, ex-Shenandoah police chief

Francis J. "Bogie" Bugdanewicz, 327 E. Lloyd St., Shenandoah, former borough police chief, died Tuesday night at home.

Born in Patriotic Hill, he was a son of the late Stanley and Eliza Beth Bugdanewicz. He attended West Mahanoy Township schools.

He was a Navy veteran of World War II.

Mr. Bugdanewicz retired as Shenandoah police chief in September of 1981 on disability. He had been chief for about seven years.

He was a member of St. George's Church, AMVETS Post 7, and Phoenix Fire Company No. 2, all of Shenandoah, Six-County Firemen's Association, Frackville Elks Lodge 1533, Fraternal Order of Police, North Schuylkill Lodge 25, Pennsylvania Northeast and Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police.

Surviving are his wife, the former Catherine Keifer, a son, Robert, Shenandoah, a daughter, Valerie, Shenandoah, two sisters, Agnes Hasara, Mahanoy City, and Helen Galenis, Shenandoah, two granddaughters.

Services will be held at 9:30 a.m. Saturday from Chaikowsky Funeral Home, Shenandoah. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. at St. George's Church. Interment will be in St. Joseph's Cemetery, Frackville.
