Daniel D. Wonderlick, 68, of 12 S. Second St., Frackville, died shortly after arrival Thursday evening at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center, Pottsville.

Born in Frackville, he was a son of the late Alexander and Stella (Bogden) Wonderlick.

Wonderlick was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Frackville, and the Knights of Columbus, Father James A. Hogan Council 2580, Frackville.

He had been employed as a quality control inspector for 21 years at Zapata Industries, Frackville, before retiring in 1988.

 Wonderlick was an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II and served in the Pacific Theater of Operations.
