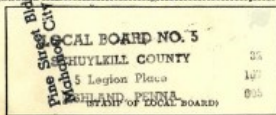

OBITUARY

Francis H. Rubright, 79, of Trappe, Montgomery County, and Clearwater, FL, died in Sanatoga Manor, Trappe area, after a lengthy illness.

Born in Frackville, he was a son of the late Howard and Elizabeth McAnulty Rubright. He was a 1936 graduate of St. Patrick's High School, Pottsville.

He served as a medic in the Army in Italy and France during World War II. After leaving the Army, he worked at the Pentagon, Arlington, VA., for 30 years as a research analyst for the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

He was a member of American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars Posts.

He was preceded in death by two wives, the former Frances Dawley and the former Elizabeth McCann Rubright.

Surviving are a son, Francis H. Jr., Alexandria, VA; a brother, Gerard, Frackville; four sisters, Agatha Buzza, Aldan; Berneice Rubright and Callista Rubright, both of Clifton Heights; and Lenore Haas, Trappe, with whom he resided; two grandchildren; a great-grandson; nieces; nephews.



Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Eleanor Catholic Church, Collegeville. Interment was in St. Joseph Cemetery, Frackville. Ruggerio Funeral Home, Trappe, was in charge of arrangements.
